

ADVANCED MANAGEMENT & SUPERVISORY LEADERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAM

South San Francisco, CA September 16 - 18, 2025

The Advanced Course is a series of skill-building days designed to help understand management's changing role in today's business climate. Leadership principles and challenges will be discussed; individual and team exercises will support specific skill training; discussions of the future of management and organizations will be central to the learning experience.

The three day course includes (8:00 am - 4:30 pm):

SECTION 1: Emotional Intelligence. Emotional Intelligence is recognized as perhaps the most critical skill of leadership. Its importance was known and taught by early philosophers. Current research in neuroscience and social science support the role of EQ for improved relationships and more effective leadership. This class will break down the skills and practices to improve self-awareness, self-management, empathy and social awareness.

SECTION 2: Ethics. Designed to help managers and supervisors fully understand the nature and necessity of change, its impact on people, and how to meet the challenge it presents. Participants learn strategies that help speed up the process and minimize the productivity decline. Emphasis is placed on coaching and leading a team through a complex change situation.

SECTION 3: Leadership; Mastering Values and Vision. Leadership is about the future, inspiring others to achieve things that are an Improvement of the current state. Clarity of vision is rooted in the values we espouse. Most managers in a variety of surveys tend to show less than average results in their capacity to lead with a vision. This class will walk through the steps of creating a vision, being visionary and leading others with a vision.

SECTION 4: Leadership; Fostering Development, Collaboration and Recognition. As managers we spend our days making decisions. How do you determine the quality of your decision making process/the quality of your outcomes? Do you have a way of determining whether something should even be a decision? We will explore methods and perspectives that will support your individual and group decision making ability.

SECTION 5: Leadership; Managing Change. We live in a world of accelerated change. We are responding to numerous changes at the same time. We must learn to manage and lead our organizations through change that involves our environment, politics, technology and demographics...to name a few. This class will explore the most effective ways to provide human guidance and technical structure through change.
